

# FOEN - Plant protection products Export

## 1. General

### 1.1 The issue at hand

Plant protection products are hazardous for the environment, which is why their use is regulated. A licence from the [FOEN](#) is mandatory in order to export plant protection products that are not authorised in Switzerland. It is prohibited to export plant protection products that are considered to be particularly hazardous in terms of human health or the environment.

### 1.4 Terminology

Plant protection products	<p>Active substances and preparations that are designed to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- protect plants and plant products against harmful organisms or prevent the action of such organisms (e.g. acaricides, fungicides, insecticides, molluscicides);</li><li>- influence the life processes of plants other than as a nutrient (phytoregulators);</li><li>- preserve plant products (storage protectants);</li><li>- destroy unwanted plants or parts of plants (herbicides); or</li><li>- control the undesired growth of plants (phytoregulators).</li></ul> <p>They also include organisms (bacteria, viruses and other microorganisms and macroorganisms [beneficial insects]) with a general or specific effect on harmful organisms with respect to plants, parts of plants or plant products (e.g. ladybirds used to combat aphids).</p>

## 2. Information in the customs/goods declaration

Anyone exporting plant protection products must provide an indication in the goods declaration regarding the restriction obligation and enter the FOEN licence.
