

SMC - TPA Article 21 paragraph 1^{bis}

1. General

1.1 The issue at hand

The export of medicinal products to execute people is prohibited. However, [Swissmedic](#) may authorise exceptions to this prohibition in individual cases and issue the corresponding export authorisation.

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2. Information in the customs/goods declaration

Anyone exporting such medicinal products must provide an indication in the goods declaration regarding the restriction obligation and declare the Swissmedic authorisation.
